



Dear Friends, Patrons, and Well wishers,

I welcome you all to Lily Foundation's 19th Annual Appreciation gala. Lily volunteers in India and USA continue to work hard in supporting our mission of breaking the poverty cycle by education. We are proud to be part of several underprivileged kids' education journey and enjoy celebrating their success. This would not have been possible without the financial impetus provided by many Lily patrons and we are highly appreciative of your continued and growing support.

This is a very special year for us as we celebrate the success of two Lily supported students Krishnendu Kundu and Tanmoy Pati. Krishnendu Kundu, son of a marginal farmer family and Tanmoy Pati, son of a daily-labor family, obtained ranks 8th and 10th respectively at West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education (grade 12 exams) from a pool of approximately 800 thousand students. Getting two board toppers in a single year is a very special feat! Success stories like these charge us up to extend our reach to as many needy students as possible and make their dreams come true.

Our educational projects in India cover the states of West Bengal, Karnataka, Jharkhand, Uttar Pradesh, with Odisha being the new addition and include SMILE (Scholarship Made for India's Less-fortunate Entrants) Scholarships, AALO study and coaching homes, computer centers, book banks and vocational training centers. The total student served population has increased to 5,189 from 4,257 students last year with an increase in majority of our individual educational projects.

We have started incorporating digital technologies in imparting education. We have introduced digital slates at four AALO High school coaching centers as a pilot project. These slates are pre-loaded with student and teacher profiles and have educational courses in English, Bengali, and Hindi. We have also defined roles for all directors on Lily board in USA based on functions to include key areas such as institutional fund raising and web and social media promotion.

I extend my heartfelt thanks to all volunteers of Lily Foundation in India and USA and my deepest gratitude to all our patrons for believing in this noble cause and providing support. Thank you for your kindness and generosity over many years in educating a child, changing a life, and transforming families!

আমাদের দৈনন্দিন জীবনে বিশেষত শিক্ষা ক্ষেত্রে ছাত্রদের শিক্ষাগ্রহণে প্রযুক্তিবিদ্যা অগ্রণী ভূমিকা নিয়েছে। বিদ্যালয়ের শিক্ষকদের প্রধান উদ্দেশ্য হলো শিক্ষার্থীদেরকে ভাদের শিক্ষা গ্রহণের ক্ষেত্রে শিক্ষণীয় বিষয় সমূহ কে আয়ত্ব করতে সহায়তা করা। এই কাজটিকে সহজ , আকর্ষণীয় ও কার্যকর করতে শিক্ষকগণ বিভিন্ন শিক্ষার উপকরণ ও প্রযুক্তিগত সহায়তা গ্রহণ করেন। আবার অভিভাবকরা বাড়িতে ছেলে মেয়েদের সঠিক শিক্ষ্যা দানের জন্য প্রযুক্তি বিদ্যার বিভিন্ন সাহায্য গ্রহণ করেন। আবার অভিভাবকরা বাড়িতে ছেলে মেয়েদের সঠিক শিক্ষ্যা দানের জন্য প্রযুক্তি বিদ্যার বিভিন্ন সাহায্য গ্রহণ করেন। আনার বিভিন্ন শিক্ষকরা ভাদের জ্ঞান দান করে ছাত্রদের অনেক সাহায্য করেন। প্রযুক্তির ব্যাবহার করে শিক্ষার্থীরা নিজেরাই অনেক আকর্ষণীয় ডিজিটাল শিক্ষার উপকরণ প্রস্তুত করতে পারে যার সাহায্যে শিক্ষার্থীরা সহজে আনন্দের সাথে ভা শিথতে পারে, ফলে ভাদের জ্ঞান সমৃদ্ধ হয়। শিক্ষকগণ ডিজিটাল শিক্ষ্যার উপকরণ ব্যাবহার করে সক্ষল ভাবে শ্রেণীতে পাঠ দান করতে পারেন, World Wide Web (WWW) এবং ইন্টারনেট এর ব্যাবহার করে শিক্ষার্থীরা ভাদের শ্রেণীকক্ষে ও পাঠ্য পুস্তুকের সীমানা ছাড়িয়ে বিশ্ব ব্যাপী জ্ঞানের সন্ধান করতে পারে। এখন যেকোনো মানুষ, যেকোনো সময়ে, যে কোনো স্থানে থেকে শিক্ষা লাভ করতে পারে। ভারতে বসেও এখন একজন শিক্ষার্থী চাইলে আমেরিকার কোনো বিশ্ববিদ্যাল্যের কোর্স করতে পারে। বাস্তবে একজন শিক্ষার্থী ভার শিক্ষককে মুথোমুথি না দেথেও বরং email, chatting, video-কনকারেন্সিং এর সাহায্যে পাঠগ্রহণ করতে পারে। Online এ শিক্ষক ভার পরীক্ষা গ্রহণ ও মূল্যায়ন করে সার্টিকিকেট প্রদান করতে পারেন, ফলে সময়ের অপচয় ও কম হয়, আনন্দ সহকারে, ছাত্ররা সেই শিক্ষা গ্রহণ করতে পারে, শিক্ষার অনেক সুযোগ পাওয়া যায় এবং জ্ঞানের সমৃদ্ধি ঘটে। এই ভাবে প্রযুক্তিবিদ্যা শিক্ষার্থীদের যথেষ্ট উন্নতি সাধন করে ওর ভাদেরকে ভাদের সাঠিক গন্তাবে পৌছে দেয়।

বর্তমান যুগে ছাত্ররা প্রযুক্তি ছাড়া শিক্ষার কথা ভাবতেই পারে না। শ্রেণী কক্ষের পার্ঠদানে তারা অমনোযোগী হয়ে পড়েছে। সর্ব ক্ষেত্রেই তারা প্রযুক্তি বিদ্যার আকর্ষণ ও প্রয়োজনীয়তা অনুভব করছে। বিদ্যালয়ের গতানুগতিক শিক্ষা লাভের পর তারা শিক্ষার বৃহত্তর ক্ষেত্রে প্রযুক্তি শিক্ষাগ্রহণে আগ্রহী হয়ে পড়ে, সাধারণ শিক্ষা গ্রহণে অনীহা প্রকাশ করে। শিক্ষাকে কোনো সংজ্ঞার মধ্যে ধরা যায় না। কিন্তু বর্তমান প্রযুক্তি নির্ভর শিক্ষা ব্যাবস্থায় আমরা দেখি জ্ঞান পিপাসা মেটাবার ইচ্ছা থাকলেও উপায় নেই আর সভ্যতা, সংস্কৃতির কথা তো ছেড়েই দিই। বর্তমান যুগের এই প্রযুক্তিগত শিক্ষা ছাত্রদের প্রকৃত শিক্ষায় অনুপ্রাণিত করে না। প্রযুক্তির প্রভাবে ছাত্ররা প্রয়োজনের বাইরে তাদের মেধা প্রয়োগ করে না। প্রযুক্তি বিদ্যার প্রভাবে প্রভাবিত ছাত্রদের মানসিক বিকাশের পক্ষে প্রযুক্তি বিদ্যা তাই খুবই ক্ষতিকারক। শিক্ষা প্রসঙ্গে রবীন্দ্রনাথ বলেছেন, " যতটুকু অত্যাবশক তাহার মধ্যে সীমাবদ্ধ হইয়া থাকা মানব জীবনের ধর্ম নহে। আমাদের দেহ সাড়ে তিন হাত, তাই বলিয়া আমরা সাড়ে তিন হাত পরিমাণ বিশিষ্ট গৃহ নির্মাণ করি না। স্বাধীন বিচরণের জন্য অনেক পরিধি বিশিষ্ট গৃহ নির্মাণ করি ". শিক্ষা প্রযুক্তি নির্ভর হয়ে পড়ায় ছাত্রদের মেধা সংকুচিত হয়ে পড়েছে।

এই অসুবিধাগুলি দূর করার জন্য শিক্ষকদের ছাত্রদের কে সময় দিতে হবে এবং সুপ্রশিক্ষন গ্রহণ করার পর প্রযুক্তি বিদ্যা বিষয়ক জ্ঞান ছাত্রদের দিতে হবে। তাহলেই প্রযুক্তি বিদ্যা শিক্ষার্থীদের জানার ইচ্ছা, জ্ঞানকে সম্পূর্ণ ভাবে সমৃদ্ধশালী করতে পারবে। তাই অবশেষে বলা যায় যে শিক্ষা ক্ষেত্রে প্রযুক্তি বিদ্যার গুরুত্ব অপরিসীম।



Dear Patrons,

Let me present you with our activities for the year 2017-2018.

Key Highlights: Student population served is 5189 (up from 4,257) students; We expanded our computer training and high school coaching homes and opened 2 new high school coaching homes, both for junior high students - in Dhulai and in Narrah, each having 22 students. Here's the breakdown of our educational projects

3 AALO Study Homes serving 65 pre-elementary school students

18 AALO Coaching Homes (up from 16) serving 365 students (up from 341):11 H. School, 7 Primary Coaching Centers 350 (up from 312) SMILE scholarships for high school and college students

- 15 Computer Centers (up from 12), now serving around 3,288 students (up from 3,143)
- 1 Vocational Training Center serving 10 students
- 6 Book Banks serving over 975 students (up from 775)

AALO Centers

<u>Pre-Primary study home</u>: We have three centers serving 65 students from pre-primary grades (kindergarten and first grade) operating at Behala, Boral and Narendrapur.

<u>Primary Coaching Center</u>: We have five centers at Dhulai, Hijaldiha, Suklai and Narrah in Bankura District serving 114 students from III and IV grades. We have two TORCHS center, one at Narrah and one at Dhulai.

<u>High School Coaching Center</u>: We have 11 centers serving 251 students in Math and English at Dhulai (3), Ghatsila (2), Narrah (2), Bandel, Hijaldiha, Baital and Asanbani for students performing poorly in school. Ganjam in Orissa is a potential High School Coaching Center now.

Lily Foundation Computer Centers and Vocational Training

We currently have 15 computer centers. We are currently serving over 3,288 students. Our computer centers are at Ghatsila, Dhulai, Kulbani, Hijaldiha, Amdanga, Bandel, Radhamohanpur, Kolkata, Jaunpur and Hubballi. Our Touch Computer Centers are gaining popularity as these are small and manageable with a student beneficiary count of average 20-30 students with up to 4 computers and limited course materials for the average high school students. We have now 3 of them at Bandel, Dhulai, and Narrah. The Computer Center sponsorship has been made to a 2-year commitment instead of a 3-year one. We have more requests of High School Computer Centers from Karnataka. We welcome sponsors for this noble cause where 300-400 students get computer education every year.

The vocational centers that were being run in collaboration with local corporate partners through the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) government scheme, have been closed as the corporate partners decided to terminate these due to lack of funding. The remaining program, sponsored by OSI Systems, offering pre-primary education and mid-day meals to 22 toddlers hailing from very poor families is ongoing. We are actively seeking new corporate partners to launch new programs.

SMILE Scholarship

We now have 350 scholars (up from 312) spread across the states of W. Bengal, Jharkhand, U.P., Odisha, and Karnataka. Odisha students were added this year. We have SMILE student clusters at Berhampur and Ganjam district. This has been a very effective program with a proven track record of 98% graduation rate for our scholars at 10th and 12th grade Board Exams, scoring extremely well with high percentage and graduating with distinction. We had to increase the award amount of the scholarship to High School as well as College students, so the sponsorship was to be increased. We have made a few other changes in our sponsorship table. We have recently expanded this program by adding scholarships for college and professional (medical, nursing and engineering) careers.

Other India initiatives

We are in the process of developing a Science Lab (Physics, Chemistry and Bio-Science) at a high School in Balichak, where scores of students can train hands-on in science experiments.

We are taking advantage of technology in quality learning by providing Digital Slates to High School Coaching students to learn and practice in a bid to improve performance.

Balurghat flood relief was organized with Chhandam, a local organization. Beneficiary count was 250.

Healthcare activities

Our healthcare initiatives such as Women's Clinic, various camps as medical, eye, asthma, bold donation remain strong in terms of number of events increasing and beneficiary counts increasing. Our plan to launch Mobile Medical Unit to help the distant village folks every month.

Events in USA

The Lily Cricket Match took place on April 28th with eight teams made up of local cricket lovers at indoor cricket stadium in Carrollton. India Association of North Texas joined in sponsoring the program. The contributions collected from the players and the funds raised supports will support our several educational projects. Lily Foundation's 2017 Annual Appreciation Dinner was held on September 9th at Plano Marriott Hotel. The elegantly decorated venue was well attended with over two hundred and seventy guests.

Our Feed the Needy (FTN) Program is in its 25th year and continues to get strong support from the community. We feed more than 200 homeless people at Union Gospel Mission Church, Fort Worth, twice a year.

The Annual Spelling Bee Contest was held on March 25th at the reputed University of Texas at Dallas campus. The contest, co-sponsored by IANT, had over 160 participants from pre-kindergarten through 8th. Grade, divided into four groups by grades.

The 14th Annual Education Conference (EDCON) was held in Hijaldiha on December with 400 students, teachers and guests combined. The next EDCON (15th) is scheduled for 23rd December, 2018 at Triguna Sen Hall of Jadavpur Univer.

- c) Expand health care related services.


We have been managing our US operations at no running infrastructure or salary expense to Lily Foundation till date and will continue to operate using the same model.






